

2009 SCOUT SHOW—BUILT FOR ADVENTURE  
Frequently Asked Questions

1. When and where is the event? Ballpark in Arlington; Saturday May 2<sup>nd</sup> 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
2. Why the Ballpark? This is a collaborative effort with Major League Baseball and BSA as part of the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration.
3. Will there be free parking? Yes, in the designated lots.
4. How do we reserve a booth? Click the link on the Circle 10 website or see your District Promotion Chair for a paper reservation form
5. When can we start setting up? Saturday May 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00 a.m.
6. Where is our booth or display located?  
There are three displays at the Ballpark: The North Lawn, 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Concourses.  
Your unit will receive an e-mail with details the week before the show.
7. What type of exhibits will there be? Cooking, knot tying, pioneering projects, pinewood derby and a host of special displays: Dallas Stars, SpeedZone, TAMU, Fast Track Racing
8. May units from other councils participate? Of course, all currently registered units are welcome
9. May we have cooking fires?  
Yes, as long as these are raised off the ground and no county wide burn ban is in effect.
10. Where is the check in/ticket check in/information booth?  
It is at the Home Plate Gate on the NW corner of the Ballpark.
11. How should we decorate our booth?  
Each booth will consist of a bare tubular frame that will be 10X10 or larger per your request. Cardboard, crepe paper, posters, flags etc. Bring your own table and chairs or rent them on site for \$10 and \$2 respectively.
12. Who gets in free? Scouts and Leaders in uniform
13. Is there a Rangers' game afterwards to attend? Yes, provided you purchased discounted tickets.
14. May we sell something? No, exhibitors do not sell any product or service on site.
15. Are there tickets for sale by units to attend the Scout Show? Yes, any unit may sell them.
16. May we drive stakes into the ground? Only outside the Ballpark in the designated display areas. There are underground utilities in these areas. These will be appropriately marked. DO NOT drive stakes down into these specified locations.
17. Can we get electricity? Yes, for an additional fee of \$25.
